Randy to speak to Chad regarding best way to handle unpaid invoices, concerns voiced about them putting a lien on the new station, discussion as to whether we should invoke insurance to cover. Will discuss further once best route is discussed with Chad.

Motion by Lundstrom to reduce the amount of the loan from \$500,000.00 to \$350,000.00, Freiberg-2nd, Roll Call Vote: Lundstromyes, Freiberg-yes, Meade-Yes, Motion carries unanimously.
